- There was a confirmation that Aldi's had bought the lot South of Walgreen's on Harlem. We discussed the impact of that being built sometime in the future. The Village Board confirmed that there was little we or they could do to stop it from being built.
- Other potential development west of McDonalds is at a standstill pending litigation between the owners in partnership of the land.

Vice President Report

- Improvements We will repaint the entrance markers in spring and repair lighting fixtures. Other landscaping improvements would be delayed until the Harlem Avenue widening project is complete and we can determine the impact.
- We discussed Old Plank Trail access and the Village of Frankfort Park District has agreed to work with us to build access to the trail but George Sarris owns that land a need to have his approval. We also discussed possible security concerns with people walking through the sub division from the trail.
- Street Light was repaired and flooding at the NE corner of Georgetown Rd. was taken care of by the Village after we met with and discussed these two issues with them.
- Route 30 \$100 million widening project is on hold.
